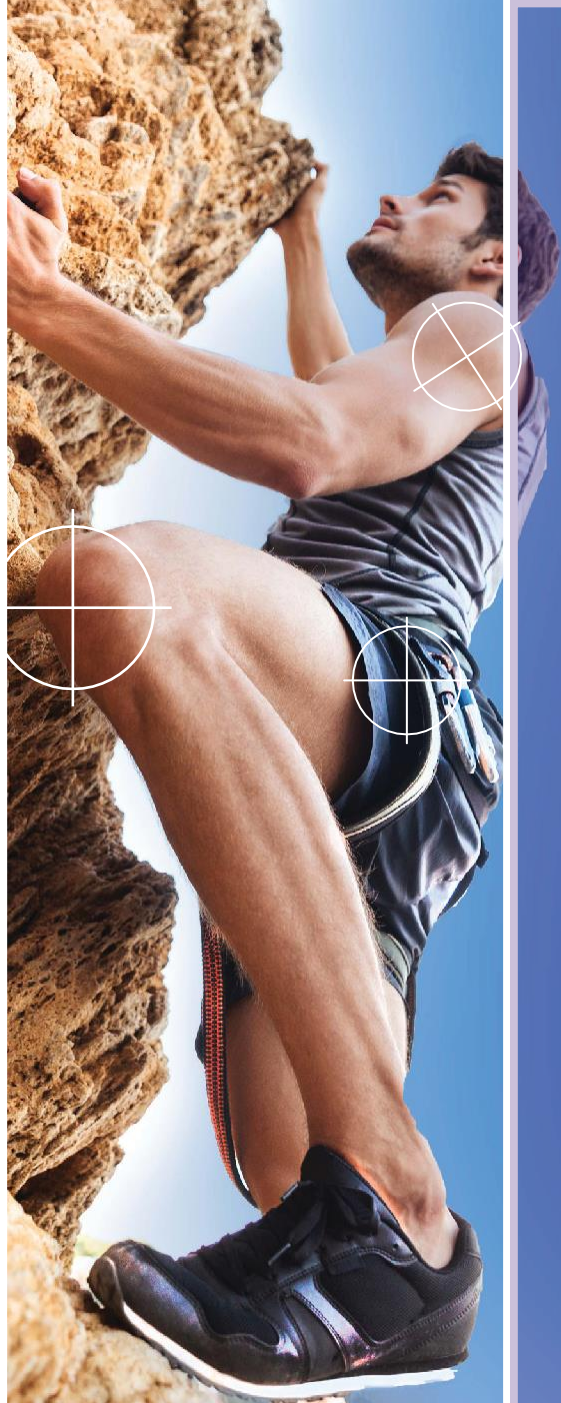
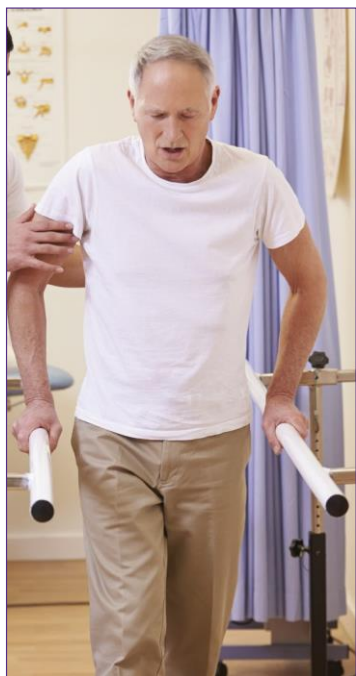

At BRS, we focus on physical therapy for patients that have had post-surgical operations, such as, knee replacements, hip replacements, rotator cuff repair, back surgery, carpal tunnel, etc. Other patients with diagnosis of a stroke, multiple sclerosis and sports injuries are also seen on a regular basis. These are just a few diagnoses, however, our staff is highly trained and capable of treating other types of diagnoses and diseases, that are typically seen in an outpatient setting.

Belvidere Rehab & Sports Medicine is equipped with four treatment rooms and one traction room. We also have a whirlpool for extremities, paraffin, electrical stimulation and ultrasound.
